And the other thing that happened is last week a -- a settlement request was put in by our counsel.

He is not very hopeful that it will be accepted by EPA, although it's possible. But the primary reason that he put that settlement request in, -- it's going in with a number of other firms -- is because he wants to be front and center with EPA on the facts of the extent of our pollution, which he wants to have early on an opportunity to show them how relatively small it is. So that even if we don't get a settlement in this round, at a subsequent round of settlement
